1. Environment Day Observance – June 5, 2025

The NSS Unit celebrated World Environment Day with great enthusiasm. The programme was inaugurated by Principal Dr. K. P. Hussain, who planted a tree in the campus garden. NSS volunteers planted five more saplings across the campus.
