### Introduction

The International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, observed annually on 26th June, is a global initiative led by the United Nations to strengthen action and cooperation in achieving a world free of drug abuse. Recognizing the significance of this day, Bafakhy Yatheem Khana Arts & Science College for Women, Kalpakanchery, took an active step in raising awareness through a comprehensive two-day program held on the 25<sup>th</sup>, 26 and 27th of June 2025.

## Poster Exhibition


Students exhibited handmade posters illustrating the dangers of drug use and the importance of awareness.
